1. Gun areas in S.E. YUGOSLAVIA are not easy to find. Apart from considerations of cover from view and crest clearance the rocky nature of the country and lack of road conditions makes accessibility the limiting factor.
2. Many recces have been made in potential areas of operations by officers of 111 Fd Regt and E Troop RSR. Their results have in some cases been embodied in previous Operational Instructions. In other cases they have not yet been disseminated.
3. At Appendix 'A' to this Instruction is attached a summary of ALL gun areas so far recce'd, under the headings of the areas to which they apply.
4. All CPO's and GPO's, and any other officers likely to find gun areas, are to have a copy of this summary. The areas should be marked on the map NOW. Any Bty or Troop may find itself operating in any of the areas.
5. Finally, the summary does not claim to be exhaustive, neither does it bind the 2 i/c, CPO or GPO to that particular spot. If a "better" one which will fulfil the requirements can be found - go to it.
