- 1) Authority has now been received for the use of the area shown in attached trace, as an Artillery Range. Allotment will be made only by this HQ.
- 2) The Officer conducting the practice will be responsible that all reasonable safety precautions are observed. These will include the following:
 - a) <u>Picquets...</u> will be posted one hour before shooting begins untilshooting ends at:

i) Road and track junction 010713ii)Road junction 055557

- iii) Both Picquets will be proved with the following instruction printed in English and Italian on millboard to be conveyed to all traffic entering the road between the two points:
- iv) "Firing is now taking place on the WEST of this road. All traffic will keep to the road and not use tracks to the West of it until Hours."
- v) These notices will be provided by RHQ.
- b) No shooting will take place within 500 yards of the road or of any house or building unless it has been cleared.
- c) Buildings will NOT be used as targets.
- d) Continuous look-out will be maintained from OP's and shooting stopped if any movement seen in the danger area.
- e) An officer or Warrant officer will be appointed as safety officer for each Troop and will be in possession of a trace showing Range boundary with 500 yards safety circle round each house or

building not cleared.

- f) Safety officers will ensure that all guns are prescribed to fire only within the prescribed area.
- 3) Any damage to Property, Personnel or animals will be reported immediately to the HQ, giving full details.
- 4) Allotments for use of the Range will be made only from this HQ, who will arrange with the Carabinieri at GRAVINA for clearing of the target area.
- 5) This HQ will arrange with the Carabinieri at GRAVINA for the farmers to be warned and range cleared. Except for the barns at 001611, which will always be cleared, <u>buildings will not be cleared unless specially requested</u> by the practicing unit. This should not be asked for unless essential as it imposed great inconvenience on the farmers.
